 - <u>This document</u> covers the new submission requirements for all eFiles submissions. The document applies equally to ARO submissions and standard review submissions. Generating consistency across submissions will help to streamline the review process. The requirements are in effect as of July 4th, 2022.
- Advisory: Increased specificity on series fee criteria
 - This advisory helps to elaborate on how series fees are applied and can be used to support ARO and standard submissions.
- Complaints Report for 2021
 - Ruling summaries for all Stage 2 or greater, complaints PAAB ruled on in 2021.
